5-a-side Football tournament

I was very pleased to be able to attend the annual 'Riddeford Shield' football tournament, held at KLB on Wednesday evening. 8 teams took part. Our team (pictured) battled valiantly against teams from larger schools and we emerged at the end of the Group Stage in second place. We dominated the first game, the ball rarely in our own half, and we had half-a-dozen good chances, but failed to convert these into goals. IMPORTANT - A change in absence policy

With immediate effect we will be requiring daily notification of absence due to illness or other unexpected absence. You can inform the school by phone message, email or ‘sent’ note. This measure is taken to tighten up a ‘grey’ area when previously we had to make assumptions about children’s whereabouts on days following an illness. You can imagine the repercussions if a child went missing, and school had just assumed they were still ill! 6 hours would have passed before anyone knew something was wrong. Please be assured that we will phone parents if we don’t receive daily notification. So, though it may be an inconvenience once in a while, I am convinced that we should adopt this better way of working to keep all children safe.
