



What to do if	Action needed	Return to school when....
...my child has COVID-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily Self-isolate the whole household Get a COVID-19 test (AND... test outcomes - see below) 	...the test comes back negative
...my child tests positive for COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us and send the email/text screenshot to admin@northnibley.gloucs.sch.uk Confirm with the school the earliest date for possible return (min. 10 days) Self-isolate the whole household 	... they feel better. They can return after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks
...my child tests negative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact school to inform us and send the email/text screenshot to admin@northnibley.gloucs.sch.uk Discuss when your child can come back (same/next day) 	...the test comes back negative and your child feels well enough to return
... my child is ill with symptoms NOT officially linked to COVID-19 (e.g. sickness and/or diarrhoea)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily Ring/email on each day of illness by 9.00 am 	... after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. As per attendance policy.
... my child is ill with symptoms NOT officially linked to COVID-19 (e.g. runny nose and/or sore throat)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use your judgement as you would under normal circumstances, PLUS ... REGULARLY check temperature, stay alert for symptoms of COVID-19 If your child is too unwell for school, stay away until their active cold symptoms have passed Ring/email on each day of illness by 9.00 am 	... they feel better, active cold symptoms have passed and they are showing no symptoms of COVID-19
...someone in my household has COVID-19 symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily Self-isolate the whole household Household member to get a COVID-19 test Inform school immediately about the test result 	...the test comes back negative
...someone in my household has COVID-19 symptoms but I cannot get a test.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily Self-isolate the whole household (14 days) Household member to keep trying to get a COVID-19 test If a test is unavailable the one with symptoms isolates for 10 days 	... they can return after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of taste/smell. These symptoms can last for several weeks
...someone in my household tests positive for COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily Confirm the earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) Self-isolate the whole household 	...the child has completed 14 days of isolation
...NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us daily and send the email/text screenshot to admin@northnibley.gloucs.sch.uk Confirm the earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) 	...the child has completed 14 days of isolation
... we/my child has travelled and has to self-isolate as a period of quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider requirements and FCO advice when booking travel Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed Confirm the earliest date for possible return (min. 14 days) Self-isolate the whole household 	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
... we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Contact school to inform us and send the email/text screenshot to admin@northnibley.gloucs.sch.uk Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	...restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again
... my child's class / year group (bubble) is sent home due to a COVID-19 outbreak in school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not come to school Your child will need to isolate for 14 days Siblings can continue to attend unless they develop symptoms or a person in the household tests positive At home, support your child with remote education 	...school informs you that the bubble will be reopened
