
MATHS CHALLENGE

Another great fundraiser for FONNS kindly helped by local businesses. LDR - Lee Dunham Racing, based in Lower Wick, is inviting children to a Oset Motor cross session.

Ages 4-6 years old \sim 9am - 12noon (Reception, years 1 &2) Ages 7-9 years old \sim 1pm - 4pm (years 3&4) We can take 8 children per session. £40.00 per child \sim which includes the bike, Helmet & body armour. LDR has kindly offered to donate £20.00 per person back to FONNS.
