



## The Music Curriculum at North Nibley C of E Primary: A statement of intent



At North Nibley C of E Primary School, our aim is to provide a high-quality music education that engages and inspires children to develop a love of music and nurtures their talent as musicians.

We recognise that through music, children can increase their self-confidence, sense of belonging, creativity and musical achievement. As children progress, they should develop a broad toolbox of musical skills, allowing them to compose and to listen and appraise a variety of musical genres and styles. Through singing songs in lessons and collective worships, children learn about the structure and organisation of music and are able to discuss these using correct musical vocabulary. We teach them to listen and to appreciate different forms of music.

To support children in learning to play a musical instrument and read formal music notation, we offer Whole Class Music Tuition at least once throughout a child's KS2 journey. A range of peripatetic music lessons are also on offer and those entitled to the Pupil Premium may choose to use the grant to include such lessons. In addition, there are opportunities within extra-curricular clubs, for example the chance to join the choir for Young Voices and perform with other schools in front of a large audience.
